#### **GENERAL NOTES**

#### Club Captain


The Club Captain is the liaison between members and the Executive, authorised to settle minor complaints and, in particular, to look after the interests of junior and new members, assisting them to obtain places in teams and to participate in the club's social activities. The Club Captain is charged with responsibility of maintaining an acceptable standard of conduct, etiquette and dress in the Club and on the greens. Members are asked to treat the Club Captain as a friend, to be sought out if in need of help or information.

#### **Complaints**

All complaints concerning staff, green, domestic or other arrangements of the Club or in respect of any Member shall be made in writing on the official club complaint form, signed by the Member complaining and addressed to the Executive. The executive will acknowledge the complaint, enquire into the same at the earliest convenient opportunity, and reply to the complainant in writing. In no instance shall a servant of the Club be reprimanded or criticized by a Member. Complaint forms are available from the Club Secretary (secretary@glenedenbowlingclub.org.nz)

#### **Dumping**

It is every member's responsibility to deliver bowls smoothly. With the availability of coaching there is no excuse for dumping. If players cause damage to the green, they may be required to seek coaching.



We have three competition grade dart boards permanently set up for members to use any time the bar is open.

#### **SPORTSMANSHIP**

## Costs nothing and adds to the enjoyment of the game, it is courteous

- In a singles match when you have lost the previous end to hand your opponent the mat and the jack.
- To stand still and behind the player, and observe silence, when the player's bowl is being delivered
- When the match is completed to thank the marker and
- congratulate the opponent.
- When playing at home and as hosts to make the visiting players welcome.
- When your team loses to congratulate your opponents.
- Never to use strong language during play or display signs of ill temper.
- To commend a good shot played by your opponent.
- When changing ends to keep within the confines of your rink.
- For leads and seconds to retire to the bank after delivering their bowls.
- That all players on or behind the head refrain from any movement that will distract the player at the other end when the bowl is being delivered.
- Not to criticise the effort of a fellow team member, who is trying just as hard as you.
- Not to blame the condition of a green for your team's defeat and in particular in front of another member of that club.

#### LAWS OF THE SPORT IN NEW ZEALAND

#### **CLUB RULES**

- 1. On Tuesday, Thursday, (except tournament weekends, Christmas and New Year and when greens are required for Championships or the Monthly Progressive) there will be a mixed roll up, with winners prizes each month
- There will be 2 games of not less than 10 ends.
   Points will be allocated as 3 points for a win,
   2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss.
   Tuesday names in by 10:15am for a 10:30am start
   Thursday names in by 10:15am for a 10:30am start
- 3. All roll ups may be played in mufti, unless playing on the same green as a Championship. Please check in the book and ring the club if in doubt.
- 4. Any members may practice in mufti. Unless playing on the same green as a Championship.
- 5. Please protect our greens, wear correct footwear (this will be strictly enforced this year) and vary the mat length when not on scrims.
- 6. Where Reserve Days for Championships are alongside Auckland Rep Days, allowances will be made for any player who is playing for Auckland or in a post Section of an Auckland Championship.
- 7. Bowls to be valid must have a 1982 or later NZBA Stamp or the current NZBA Test Stamp imprinted.
- 8. For Club Championships and centre events Club shirts with black/white pants and teams to be dressed the same. Tournaments bowling attire excluding jeans.
- 9. Midweek tournaments will be mufti.
- 10. Auckland Events & Auckland Rep teams must wear the same coloured club shirt and pants.

## CONDITION OF PLAY FOR ALL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

### Entry Fee for all Championships and Handicaps - \$10.00 per player

All competitions will be played under N.Z.B.A rules.

• All members must be financial to play in any club organized event.

• The bowls committee reserves the right to alter conditions

of play.

 Members may be asked to play matches in twilight and/ or on artificial green, if rain interferes with the scheduled programme and weekend days are running out.

 A condition of entry for all Singles events is that you shall act as marker if required (except Consistency Singles)

 A substitute or replacement in any Championship must be approved by the controlling body and will play in the position of the player she/he is substituting or replacing, except she/he cannot play skip.

Veteran events are restricted to members who are 60 years and over at the date of an event. These are limited to 3 games per day and will be played on a weekend as available.

• Players who are members of more than one club in different centres or Centre Districts at the same time, may enter and play in all disciplines in each centre.

 If a player wins a discipline or disciplines in one or more club championship, she/he shall be eligible to represent such club in their winning discipline at the Champions of Champions events at each centre or centre district.

• If a Champion of Champion's event in the player's relevant discipline is scheduled to be played at the same time, then the player shall represent and play for the first club for which they won their discipline at the Club Championships.

 If a player plays the same discipline at another club, but starts at GEBC first, they must finish at GEBC.  The controlling body shall not permit any bowler who cannot represent the club in a Champ of Champ event to be replaced, if that player chooses to play in another event unless he is to represent Bowls New Zealand.

• Three games per day of 18 ends. Two life system - Time limit 2.5hrs. 3 bowls.

• Three games per day of 15 ends. Two life system - Time limit 2.5hrs. 2 bowls.

 To be played as a Round Robin, depending on entries and 21 points.
