The winners with 4 out of 4 wins were Judy Raill, Jenny Tough, Jeff Tough, & Barry Shaw.




In 2nd place was a visiting team from Pukekohe: Mike Cavanagh, Sean Pennell, Gavin Wesche, & Mike Wass.
